

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CONTROL
OF FARM ANIMALS AND FOWL
IN THE TOWN OF NEW LONDON**

It shall be unlawful for any person to keep hogs, cows, horses, goats, sheep or any other farm animal including fowl in the town on any property less than one (1) acre in area. In any case of keeping of horses and cows, such animals shall be kept within an enclosure on said property and the maximum population of said cows and/or horses shall not exceed one animal per acre of enclosed area. In any case of keeping hogs, goats, sheep other farm animals or fowl other than horses and cows, such animals or fowl shall be kept in an enclosure which is at least two hundred (200) feet from any public street or dwelling which is not a part of the one (1) acre property.

This ordinance was adopted by the New London Town Board on the 11th day of November, 2008.
