AN ORDINANCE FOR THE TOWN OF NEW LONDON, NORTH CAROLINA, PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF TRASH, REFUSE, SHAVINGS, PAPER, LEAVES, LITTER OR OTHER MATERIAL OF ANY KIND ON OR IN ANY PUBLIC STREET, AVENUE, ROAD, ALLEY OR SIDEWALK IN THE TOWN OF NEW LONDON, NORTH CAROLINA; DECLARING THE VIOLATION THEREOF AS CLASS III MISDEAMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of New London, North Carolina, as follows:

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn or cause to be burned any trash, refuse, shavings, paper, leaves, litter or other material on or in any public street, avenue, road, alley, or sidewalks in the Town of New London.
- 2. Violation of the provision of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be a Class III Misdemeanor as defined in N.C.G.S. 14-4 punishable by a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- 3. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its adoption.

This ordinance was adopted by the New London Town Board on the 2nd day of February, 1998.
