Present for the meeting were Mayor Tate Daniels, Commissioners Bill Peak, Richard Kimmer, Christy Starnes and Marcus Mullis. Commissioner Johnny Chestnut was absent from the meeting. Visitors present at the meeting were John & Cathy Kimmer, Derek Starnes and Jason Cagle.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Bill Peak. Mayor Daniels opened the Public Hearing. The purpose of the hearing was to review the recommendation by the Planning Board regarding a request from Fiberon and Mr. Joe Frank Harris to re-zone 1.8 acres of property owned by Mr. Harris at 839 Austin Road from R-20 to M-1. Fiberon's property surrounds this parcel of land, and they would like to purchase this property and have the zoning match the rest of their operations at 181 Random Drive.

Following discussion, Mayor Daniels closed the Public Hearing and opened the Commissioner's Meeting. Commissioner Mullis made a motion to approve this request to rezone the property at 839 Austin Road from R-20 to M-1, seconded by Commissioner Kimmer. Motion carried unanimously.
