

**ORDINANCE BANNING COMPRESSION BRAKING
WITHIN THE TOWN OF NEW LONDON, NORTH CAROLINA**

ENGINE COMPRESSION BRAKES PROHIBITED ON THE STREETS OF NEW LONDON;

No person shall use a motor vehicle on any street, road or highway within the Town of New London's jurisdiction where the engine compression brake is in any way engaged or activated on such motor vehicle or any unit apart thereof, except for emergency situations for the purpose of avoiding a collision with another object, person or vehicle. Engine compression brakes means a device primarily on trucks for the conversion of the engine from an internal combustion engine to an air compressor for the purpose of braking without the use of wheel brakes (commonly referred to as a "jake" brake, "Jacob's brake", engine brake or dynamic braking device).

Any person or persons violating the provision of this section shall be subject to a fine of \$100.00 on the first count and \$200.00 for each count thereafter.
